8 Things God Has for You in 2024

1. Provision

Nothing and no one are outside of God's control and because of this, we can trust that as His children, God will provide everything we need.— *Romans* 8:28

2. Direction

Sometimes knowing what the next step is or even knowing the right way to go can be difficult and scary. But God has already let us know that He will let us know which way to go.— *Psalm 32:8*

3. Strength

We are so quick to rely on our own ability and strength, but God instructs us to trust in Him and His strength.— <u>Proverbs 3:5-6</u>

4. Thankfulness

God's will for every part of our lives includes making thankfulness a posture of our heart that we should practice continually.— <u>1 Thessalonians 5:18</u>

5. Obedience

When we are fully obedient to God, then we are actually doing what we have been created to do. When we practice obedience, we get to experience true freedom and joy. – <u>Luke 9:23</u>

6. Wisdom

God doesn't require anything from us that He won't equip us to do. When we lack wisdom, we ask and God not only gives it, but gives so generously.- <u>James 1:5</u>

7. Intimacy

The type of intimacy we have with God is like nothing else. Not only did He create us, but He knows every hair on our head, every tear we've cried, every thought we've had or thing we've done. – <u>Jeremiah 1:5</u>

8. Refuge

If you trust in and love Him, God will never forsake you or leave you. We see this evidence in the presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives. What a good God, that He would be with us always! – <u>Psalm 9:10</u>
